RECIPE OF THE MONTH: ORANGE CHILLER

- 5 c icy cold milk made from non-fat dry milk crystals
 - 1 6 oz. can frozen orange juice concentrate
 - 1 c sugar (more or less or none)
 - 1 c lemon-lime carbonated beverage
- Pour ½ milk into large jar, pitcher or blender. Add orange juice concentrate. Mix well. Add rest of milk. Add lemon-lime carbonated beverage if desired. Makes about 7 cups.
